<b>DATE</b>	October 4-6, 2019
<b>Airline</b>	<p>Athletes are responsible for their own transportation to and from Oklahoma City, OK.</p> <p>We will have busing from the OKC Airport to Regatta Site at 12:30 PM. <b>Bus Transportation</b>	<p>Buses will be transporting the athletes, coaches and chaperones from the airport to directly to the Boathouse District on October 4, 2019. After practice, everyone will be transported to the hotel for dinner.</p> <p>Buses will be transporting the athletes, coaches and chaperones to and from the Boathouse District regatta site and the hotel throughout the day on October 5, 2019.</p> <p>On October 6, 2019, the rowers are asked to pack up all their belongings and place them on the bus. We will <b>NOT</b> be returning to the hotels after the race. We will be departing for airport once racing has concluded.</p>

<b>Photo ID</b>	All athletes should bring photo ID with them. Athletes that are 18 or older will need it to fly.

<b>Tentative Schedule</b>	<p><b>Friday:</b> Athletes will be transported to the hotel from the regatta site for practice and will check into the hotel after practice. Dinner will be served at the hotel.</p> <p><b>Saturday:</b> Full breakfast at the hotel Lunch will be provided at the race site Team Dinner will be served at the hotel.</p> <p><b>Sunday:</b> Full breakfast at the regatta site. Athletes will be shuttled to the course with their boats and based on race time (schedule TBD) Lunch will be provided at the race site Athletes will be taken to the airport on a bus.</p>
<b>Travel Note</b>	<b>Athletes are expected to participate in all of the above activities. Any other plans, even if it is with parents, must be cleared by a chaperone first. Athletes must be accounted for at all times.</b>
